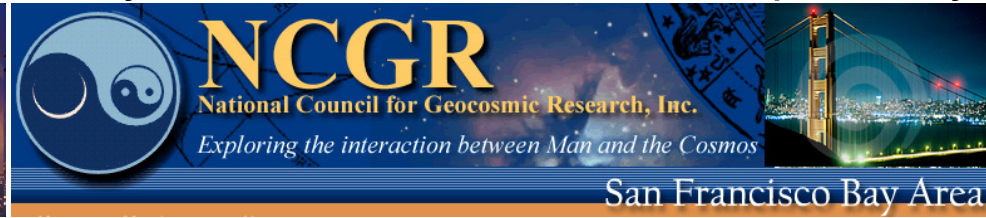

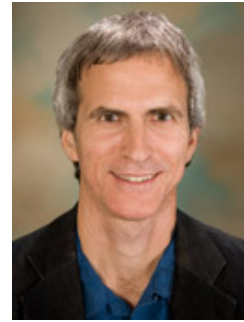

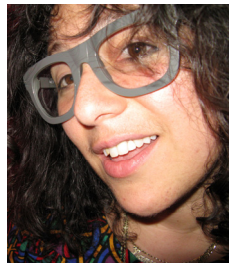

**KEYNOTE ADDRESS: ASTROLOGY AND COMMUNITY Jeff Jawer - 6:15 PM – 7:30 PM**

The practice of astrology primarily addresses the character and cycles of individuals. The psychological development of 20th century astrology contributed to trends of individualism that have created both a sense of freedom and alienation.
